

Journal for the Society of North Carolina Archivists:

During 2010-2011, two issues of *J-SNCA* were published. The newly established credit card that is attached to SNCA's bank account was not used until the second issue was published in 2011, but that was extremely helpful in making the reimbursement process much easier for the current Publications Chair.

The cost breakdowns for the two issues that were produced last year are listed below:

Volume 8, Issue 1:

Journals:	\$444.25	(\$415.00 for printing, \$29.25 for shipping)
Supplies:	\$36.69	
Postage:	\$193.14	(\$1.00 per 189 journals + 4.14 for mailing to the featured authors)
Total Cost:	\$674.08	

Volume 8, Issue 2:

Journals:	\$523.75	(\$467.50 for printing, \$56.25 for shipping)
Supplies:	\$12.99	(had leftover supplies from the previous issue)
Postage:	\$104.96	(\$1.68 per 61 journals + \$2.48 for mailing to the featured authors)
Total Cost:	\$641.70

The North Carolina Archivist:

Two issues of the SNCA newsletter were published in 2010-2011. To create the Spring 2010 issue, the Publications Chair worked with Katie Nash, of Elon University, who had graciously volunteered to serve as the Newsletter Editor. The Newsletter Editor then took over all of the duties for the newsletter's publication for the Fall 2010 issue. Katie Nash has also agreed to continue to serve as our Newsletter Editor for 2011.

The Publications Chair and Newsletter Editor also attempted – albeit unsuccessfully – to find someone who could create a redesign for the Microsoft Publisher template that is used for *The North Carolina Archivist*. It is hoped that this effort can be carried out in the next year, however.

Goals for next year (and beyond):

1. Create a committee to complete the work of contacting former *J-SNCA* authors who did not sign a contract so that past issues may be indexed by EBSCO.
2. Find a volunteer who will create a new template for *The North Carolina Archivist*.
3. Update the J-SNCA webpage to cover the most recent issue's "Table of Contents" sections. Currently, this page only includes up to Vol. 5, No. 2, Winter 2007.
4. Update the EAD file for the "Finding Aid of the Society of North Carolina Archivists Records" that is hosted online at the North Carolina State Archives.
5. Continue to talk with the J-SNCA Editorial Board and the SNCA Electronic Resources Chair about possibilities to publish online editions of *J-SNCA* and *The North Carolina Archivist*.
